

Why is academic progress so critical in a residential treatment setting?

Many students come to us significantly behind in school and in academic ability due to emotional and/or mental health struggles. It is critical that your student receive top-notch academic instruction so they can catch up to their peers.

How do you measure academic growth?

Academic growth is measured using the NWEA MAP Growth standardized test, covering math, reading, and language usage. The change in RIT score shows that our students are getting more than a year's worth of growth compared to the national norm. Testing occurs within 30 days of program entry and around 10 months later, mirroring a standard school year for effective growth assessment.

How are our students making so much academic progress?

Our students benefit from a dynamic and engaging curriculum, small class sizes allowing for personalized learning, and talented and caring teachers in the classroom with them each day.



Math

Students at Oxbow Academy made 40% more growth on their math scores than the national average between the 2022 -2024 school years.

Language

Students at Oxbow Academy made 15% more progress on their language scores than the national average between the 2022 -2024 school years.

Reading

During the 2022-2024 school years, students at Oxbow Academy **scored 13% higher on their reading scores than** the national average.

Overall

Students at Oxbow Academy made 25% more growth on their overall RIT scores than the national average between the 2022 -2024 school years.
